



S-Bahn: Flumserberg is the only winter sports region that can be reached by urban railway (S-Bahn). At weekends and on public holidays, the S2 runs every hour from Zurich Airport to Unterterzen. The S4 urban train also runs every hour from Uznach and Sargans. For more information visit: **www.sbb.ch**

Postauto: From Sargans station, the post bus takes you via Flums into the winter sports area. An even more convenient way to get to the ski slopes and then back home again.

A fine will be imposed for any infringement of this rule, and your ski pass will be withdrawn. The ski slopes are closed outside the cable car operating times and are not secured from risks. Sledging fun

Prodalp-Tannenheim sledging run

Race down our exciting sledging run into the valley and feel the snow blowing on your face - great fun for young and old. The sledges for this adventure can be hired on site. This sledging run is moderate and not suitable for small children, dogs are not allowed.

Sledge transport

Sledges can be carried on the following lifts: gondola SeeJet and Prodalp-Express; on the gondola BergJet and chairlift Panüöl only for small children.

Children's sledging slopes

For the little ones, there are two children's sledging slopes for free use on Prodalp and Tannenboden.



Extract from the GTC

General

The General Terms and Conditions (GTC) apply to all services and products provided by Bergbahnen Flumserberg AG and Luftseilbahn Unterterzen-Flumserberg AG (individually or jointly referred to as the "Company"), including the online ticket shop, rental of sports equipment etc. In the event of an order, purchase or use, the GTC are deemed to have been accepted without reservation. Where tickets have age categories, the date of birth on the (first) day of use applies for single journeys, day tickets or multi-day tickets, and the year of birth for annual tickets.

Prices and terms of payment

All prices are quoted in CHF including the statutory VAT. In addition to cash in CHF, EUR and Reka-Checks, the Company accepts all well-known cashless payment methods, the Flumserberg and the Heidiland gift card. The Company also accepts payment in EUR at physical points of sale. The exchange rate used is determined by the Company. Change is given in CHF. Price reductions cannot be combined.

Tickets & Ticket Misuse

All tickets are for personal use only and are non-transferable. This does not apply to point cards and free-choice day passes. These can only be used by one person each day and expire after the printed expiry date. The ticket office, railway or authorised control personnel are entitled to check tickets at any time. Any misuse of tickets (transfer, resale) will result in immediate cancellation of the ticket without compensation. A surcharge of CHF 150.00 will be imposed. A valid ticket must also be purchased.

Concessions

Senior citizens as from their 60th birthday and handicapped persons qualify for a concession. Evidence is required. The senior citizens' concession is only valid from Mondays to Fridays on day tickets; the concession does not apply on Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays.

Refunds

No refunds will be given in the event of the loss of the ticket, personal reasons preventing use of the ticket, early departure or adverse weather conditions. Access may be subject to reduced rail operations (especially in the early and late season). Reductions of this nature do not give rise to any entitlement to refunds. Refunds due to accident, illness or death will be made on presentation of a doctor's or other certificate. The entitlement to a refund only exists if the ticket has not been used after the date of the event and an application for a refund is made before the end of the season.

Groups

In winter, the Company offers different price levels for groups of 10, 65 and 150 persons. Groups are deemed to be groups with a closed membership such as associations, clubs, organisations and companies. The group leader must order, purchase and pay for the tickets for all members. Every 12 paying persons (fares without half-fare travel card/ GA) entitle the group to one free ticket.

Schools

The school tariff applies exclusively to officially recognised schools in accordance with the Swiss Schools Act (SSchG) with a minimum of 10 participants.

Extract from the Transport Regulations

Children less than 1.25 m tall may only be carried on a chairlift if accompanied by a parent, carer or other appropriate adult. That person must sit next to the child/children. No more than two children may sit side by side. Parents, or those persons to whom parents have entrusted their children (e.g. friends, instructors etc.), are responsible for the children. Children must not be carried by giving a piggy-back.


